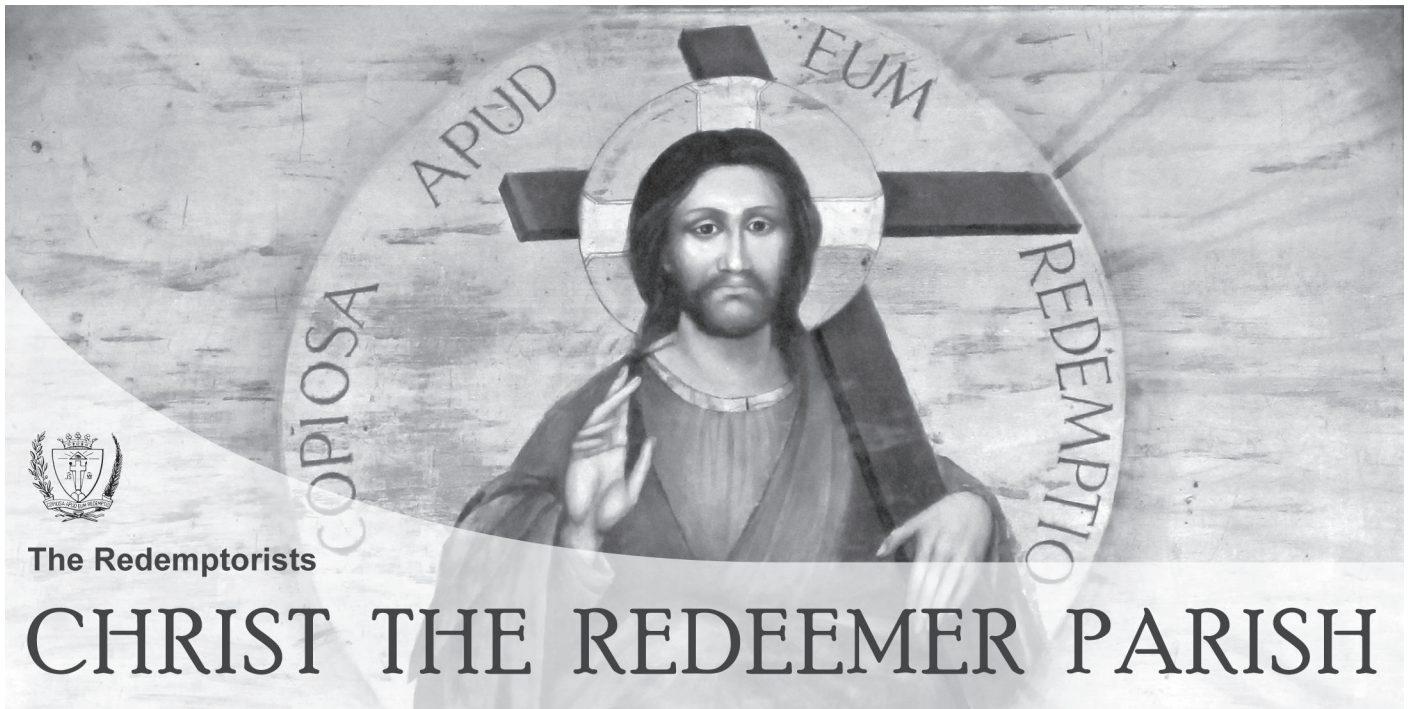

*"In my Father's house there are many dwelling places. If there were not, would I have told you that I am going to prepare a place for you? And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back again and take you to myself, so that where I am, you also may be." - Jn 14:2-3*

### 5TH SUNDAY OF EASTER

"I will come back again and take you to myself, so that where I am you also may be." Now this is something to look forward to: being where Jesus is, in heaven. What could be more satisfying, more beautiful, more perfect? Heaven is where we find the "fulfillment of the deepest human longings" (Catechism of the Catholic Church §1024). Our longing for love that doesn't fail, our longing for peace that doesn't end, our longing for happiness that doesn't fade away—all of this is awaiting us. Today, Jesus tells his disciples that he is going to "prepare a place" for them. We are his disciples too, and so we also have a spot in the "Father's house." But we need to make sure we know how to get there!

This is what Thomas the (doubting) Apostle asked about in today's Gospel: "How can we know the way?" Thomas wants to be sure about things. He is looking for a kind of spiritual roadmap to give him the confidence that he's on the right path. This is what we have in Jesus. He responds to Thomas' question with these words: "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." In other words, Jesus is like an infallible heavenly GPS. He gets us where we want to go.

By heeding Christ's teachings and following his example, we can navigate through the many competing "ways" that vie for our attention. But more than just serving as a spiritual signpost, Jesus wants us to be in a real relationship with him. As he asks Philip today, "Have I been with you for so long a time and you still do not know me?" If Jesus himself is the way, then it is only by truly knowing him that we will find our way to heaven where we will finally behold him face-to-face.

**SACRAMENT OF ORDINATION IN OUR DIOCESE AND IN THE CONGREGATION OF THE REDEMPTORISTS**

The months of May and June are times when many young men are ordained to the ministry in the Church. On May 17<sup>th</sup> - two men from our Diocese (Edgar Madarang and David Skoblov) will be ordained to the diaconate (next year to the priesthood). On May 31<sup>st</sup> - an American Redemptorist (David Varghese) will be ordained to the priesthood in Annapolis, MD and a Polish Redemptorist (Paweł Burda) will be ordained to the priesthood in Tuchów, Poland.

Please, keep these young men in your prayers and also pray for new vocations to the priesthood, diaconate, religious life and ministry in the Church.

**Greetings from the Office of the Diaconate**

Over the next several months, the Office of the Diaconate will be publishing articles about the ministry of deacon. The articles will be presented in a question and answer format. Our goal is for you to become more familiar with the ministry of deacons, their role in our Church and the requirements for ordination.

**Question #8:**

How does someone know if he has a vocation to be a deacon?

There is a maxim that says "Grace builds on nature." In many cases, a person's diaconal qualities have been observed and experienced by friends, family, and members of a parish community; in these cases, it is often some of these people, or a pastor, who suggest to a man that he ought to consider the possibility of the diaconate. Perhaps a man has become interested in the diaconate because of his own experience with deacons or through something he has read. In every case, a person who thinks he might have a vocation to the diaconate should first pray, then talk about it with his family, if he's married, and find out more by calling the director of the diaconate for the diocese in which he lives.
