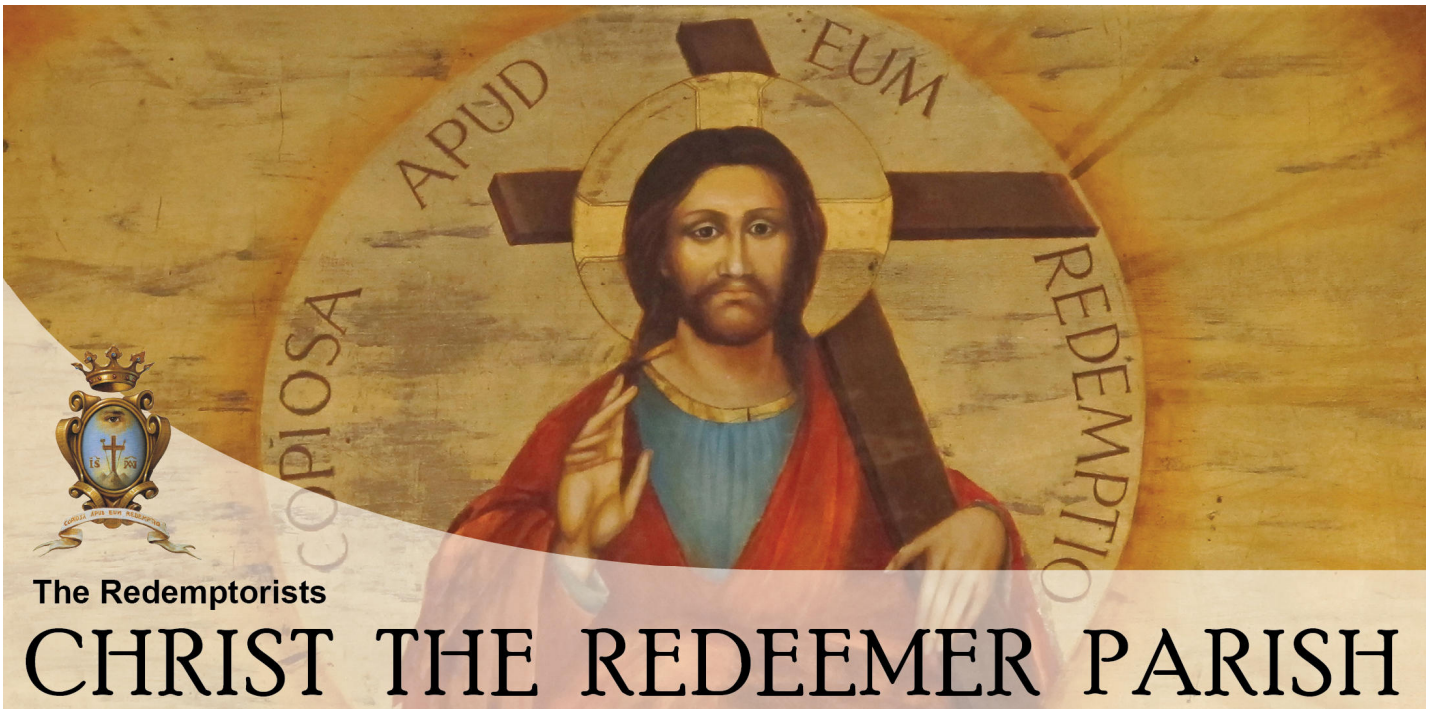

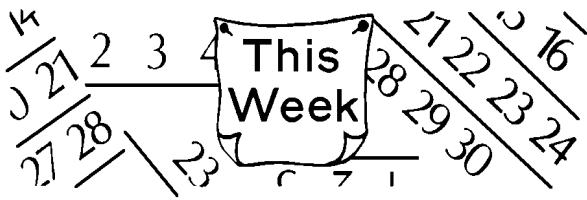
*Jesus said to them in reply, "Go and tell John what  
you hear and see: the blind regain their sight, the  
lame walk, lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the  
dead are raised, and the poor have the good news  
proclaimed to them."  
- Mt 11:4-5*

## 3RD SUNDAY OF ADVENT

"The blind regain their sight, the lame walk, lepers are  
cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised." Jesus has quite  
a résumé. When asked whether or not he is the long await-  
ed Messiah, Jesus replies with this list of his creden-  
tials, to be sure. These signs and wonders speak vol-  
umes, to be sure. But perhaps the most interesting line on  
the list is his concluding one, "the poor have the good news  
proclaimed to them." Why does he count this among his  
litany of miracles? What is so remarkable about sharing  
good news?

Perhaps Jesus included this element of his work--the  
preaching of good news--to remind his followers that the  
physical healings were not the ultimate goal of his mission.  
Rather, the spiritual healing that comes from hearing the  
good news of salvation is what Jesus was really about. The  
"poor"--which in a sense means all of us sinners, trapped by  
the poverty of the sins that enslave us--are freed by Jesus'  
message of a loving God who wants to bring us into his  
kingdom. Our poverty is erased by his richness. His mercy  
"undoes" our sin and we are invited to become the children  
of God who share in the glories of his heavenly abode.

Sometimes it's tempting to just want the visible mira-  
cles. But the invisible ones--the conversions that take place  
in the silence of the human heart--are truly the more im-  
portant works of God. Such interior transformation is what  
leads us to eternal life; even a physical cure won't last for  
eternity--death still comes at some point. But the really  
good news is that this miracle of conversion is available to  
all of us. And this season of Advent is the perfect time to  
let God work his miracles in our hearts.

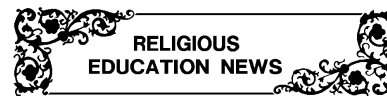

## Stewardship Knights of Columbus # 6573 Bible Study

Anthony Scarpantonio has been facilitating the Bible Study for Christ The Redeemer since 2012, and has been studying various books throughout the Old and New Testament. He uses videos, along with books to delve deeper into good Catholic Commentary on the Scripture. What he does is to come up with a program that spotlights a single book, or books, or topics that are shown in Scripture. They meet weekly from September until May or June on Thursday nights at 7pm- 8:30pm in the "Red Schoolhouse" building in the Sacred Heart Parking Lot. The cost is based on the cost of the materials and averages \$2-\$3 per week per person. We also encourage people to come to our meetings without the burden of costs; i.e. some cannot commit to an extended class-we tell them just to stop in occasionally- no "Strings". We average 7-9 people per week who attend. We continuously find that by studying scripture, we develop a greater appreciation in, not only the word of God, but a better understanding of our faith. People are always commenting how they have never quite understood the readings, the stories, and what it actually means to love and be a child of God. Additionally we go over some "Apologetics" to learn how to defend, and answer questions about being Catholic. ## CEMETERY NEWS

### WIADOMOŚCI DOTYCZĄCE CMENTARZA PARAFIALNEGO

WITH THE CHRISTMAS SEASON JUST AHEAD OF US, IT'S TIME TO REMIND EVERYONE OF THE POLICIES PERTAINING TO GRAVE DECORATIONS. WREATHS ARE THE PREFERRED DECORATION; THEY SHOULD BE TIED TO THE MONUMENT. IF YOU WISH TO USE A GRAVE SPRAY, BE SURE THAT IT IS PLACED AGAINST THE MONUMENT AND TIED TO IT. **DO NOT USE GRAVE BLANKETS** THAT SPAN THE ENTIRE LENGTH OF THE GRAVE. **ABOVE ALL, DO NOT USE METAL STAKES TO FASTEN THE DECORATIONS TO THE GROUND.**

VIGIL LIGHTS SHOULD BE REMOVED FOR THE WINTER MONTHS. BREAKAGE CAN RESULT FROM THE FREEZE-THAW ACTION. THE CEMETERY IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR VIGIL LIGHTS FOR ANY REASON.
