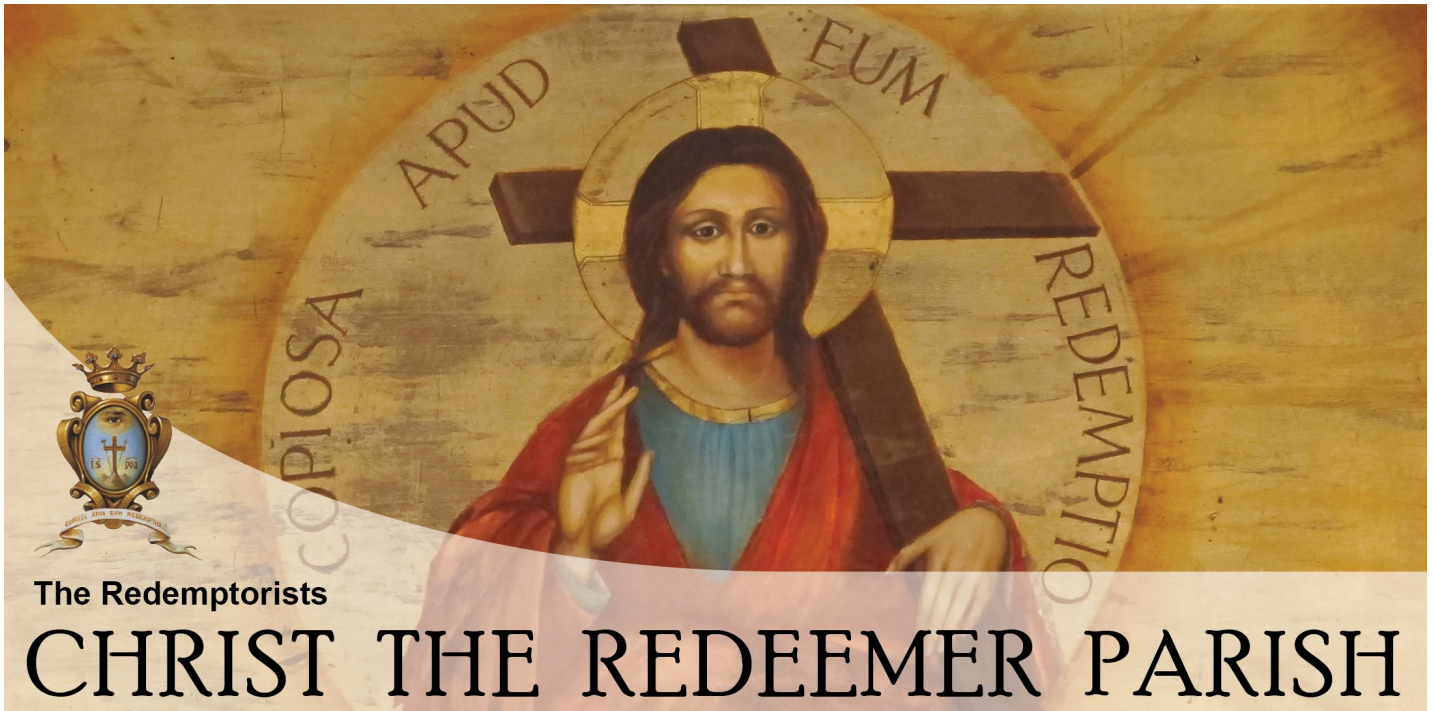

GOSPEL MEDITATION -

ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

Dorothy Day, the great Catholic activist, doubted God's existence. At least in her early adult years. But something changed when after giving birth to her daughter, she experienced an overwhelming gratitude. She later described how, as she held her daughter, the only appropriate response was a kind of unlimited gratitude. She had done nothing to deserve such a gift, this tiny, miraculous life, but there she was, flooded with gratitude, completely undone by the love of such a Giver.

Something similar occurs in Luke 17:19 when Jesus tells a healed leper, "Stand up and go; your faith has saved you." This man had already received physical healing through his faith. But the moment of an even deeper transformation came when he turned back, fell at Jesus' feet, and gave thanks. Like Dorothy, this man's gratitude led him to encounter the Giver.

Isn't that what we want, too? Gratitude to God has the power to break our chains of sadness, bitterness, and disenchantment. It empowers us to step out of the prison of self-pity and into the reality of God's abundant love. It shifts our focus from what we lack to what we have received, from what wounds us to what heals us.

Where do we learn this? The Mass. The priest prays: "It is truly right and just, our duty and our salvation, always and everywhere to give you thanks." Always.

Everywhere. Not just when life is easy. Not just when prayers are answered as we expect. Gratitude is not a passive feeling; it is an act of faith. In the eucharist, we remember that Christ himself has given everything for us. And in this act of gratitude, we are healed.

The Zeal of the Convert

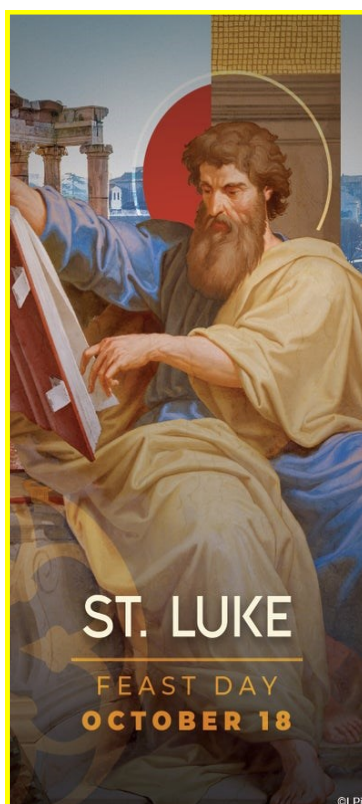
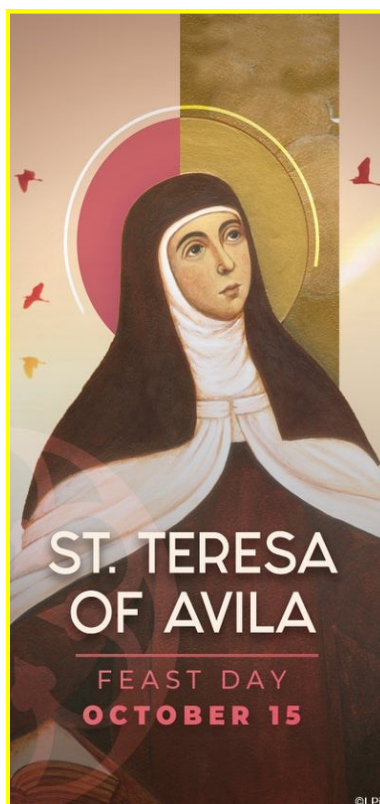
When you work in the Church, professionally or on a volunteer basis, you become familiar with the phenomenon known as "the zeal of the recent convert."

Sometimes, it really seems that the newly baptized are just stronger Catholics than the cradle Catholics. They smile more at Mass. They are awestruck by the Eucharist. They come out of the confessional beaming.

It's not that they are naive. It's not that they are in some honeymoon phase of religion, living outside of reality. It's simply that they remember. They remember what it felt like before the Eucharist or before Confession. They recall before the sacraments and the oil and the grace and the relief. It was more recent for them than for some of us older Catholics — especially those of us who were baptized as infants.

Let's ask ourselves: Have we become too comfortable? Do we receive God's grace with expectation instead of surprise? Have we ceased to marvel and wonder at the goodness of God? If the answer is a resounding yes, don't despair. Look at the Gospel — a literal nine times out of ten, God goes un-thanked and un-noticed. So many of us have forgotten, or never understood, what it meant when the leprosy was washed from our souls. But when we remind ourselves, we become more keenly aware of the extraordinariness of the gift we have received.

Darowizna spadkowa – trwale dziedzictwo wiary

Wielu parafian poszukuje dziś głębszych form zaangażowania w życie Kościoła i wspólnoty parafialnej. Jednym ze sposobów, który niesie ze sobą szczególną wartość, są darowizny spadkowe – wyjątkowa forma wsparcia, dzięki której można w trwały sposób przyczynić się do rozwoju parafii. Darowizny spadkowe to piękny gest – wyraz troski, solidarności i wizji lepszego świata.

To świadome decyzje podejmowane mogące zmienić jutro. Niezależnie od wielkości darowizny, każdy testament jest znakiem wiary i miłości względem parafii i dzieła głoszenia obfitego odkupienia w Jezusie Chrystusie.

Darowizna przekazana w testamencie nie obciąża codziennego budżetu, ponieważ jest realizowana przez wykonawcę testamentu po śmierci darczyńcy. To wyraz roztropnego i odpowiedzialnego planowania, które pozwala ofiarować coś naprawdę znaczącego – nie tylko materialnie, ale przede wszystkim duchowo.

Tego rodzaju dar:

ma wpływ na kolejne pokolenia,

jest trwałym świadectwem wiary,

wyraża miłość i troskę o wspólnotę,

zachęca do refleksji nad duchowym dziedzictwem, które zostawiamy po sobie.

Zachęcamy do rozważenia tej szczególnej formy daru na rzecz naszej parafii. Może ona stać się nie tylko konkretnym wsparciem, ale również trwałym dziedzictwem wiary i duchowym świadectwem dla przyszłych pokoleń, który przetrwa lata.

Niech Twoje dziedzictwo stanie się błogosławieństwem dla przyszłych pokoleń.

Studium wykonalności

We współpracy z diecezją Metuchen prowadzone jest studium wykonalności, którego celem jest określenie zakresu prac koniecznych do wykonania zarówno na plebanii, jak i w kościele Najświętszego Serca Jezusowego.

Nasz kościół nie przechodził poważnych renowacji od ponad 50 lat, a w przypadku naszej stuletniej plebanii – jeszcze dłużej. Oba budynki wymagają gruntownych remontów,

Cztery główne projekty, które należy zrealizować, to: remont plebanii parafialnej, wymiana dachu kościoła Najświętszego Serca Jezusowego, remont wnętrza kościoła, wsparcie Apelu Biskupiego 2026.

Badanie prowadzi pan Richard Lanahan, dyrektor Biura Rozwoju Zarządzania Diecezji Metuchen. Powinni Państwo już otrzymać list podpisany przez ojca Proboszcza z prośbą o udział w ankiecie.

Studium ma zakończyć się do końca 2025 roku. Wszystkie odpowiedzi zostaną zestawione i opracowane przez diecezję, a wyniki zostaną przekazane o. Stanisławowi na początku 2026 roku. Następnie zostaną ogłoszone i opublikowane w biuletynie parafialnym.

Państwa opinia jest dla nas niezwykle cenna. Udział w ankiecie odegra kluczową rolę w kształtowaniu przyszłości naszej parafii.

(PRACTICING) CATHOLIC – BENEATH THE SURFACE

Your faith has saved you. These are the words I pray I will hear when my heart stops beating, when the last breath has left my lungs.

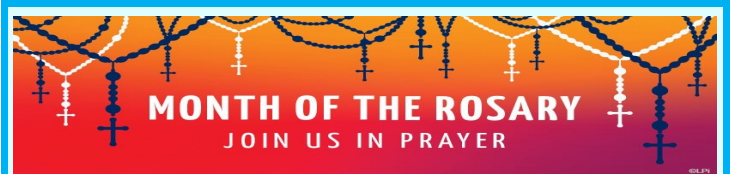
We hear Jesus say these words, or words like them, several times in the Gospels: to the woman bold enough to grasp for his cloak in a crowd, to the men who testify to their belief that he can restore their sight, to the leper kneeling before him in thanks. These are some of my favorite passages in all of Scripture, because they illustrate so beautifully what salvific faith is — and what it is not. It's so easy to think that I have done all the necessary work by simply believing. Yes, Christ is my Savior. Yes, the Church is his bride. Yes, this doctrine is true, that dogma is infallible, so on and so forth.

I believe! Well, so what? Satan believes, too. It doesn't do him any good.

The lepers had faith — so they begged Jesus to heal them. They had faith — so they followed his instructions and went to the priests. Their faith was sufficient to motivate these actions, which led to their physical healing. But only one had faith strong enough to understand that physical healing doesn't mean anything without spiritual results. Only one had enough faith to go back to the source of his healing and say, "Thank you. Now what?"

I have enough faith to know that God can heal me. But do I have enough faith to embrace the purpose for which He heals me? If Jesus tells you that your faith has saved you, he isn't talking about faith as merely an internally held belief. In each of these Gospel passages, he's talking about faith as a conviction that is making itself seen. Heard. Felt. He's talking about an arm that is reaching for the hem of a garment, a voice that says "I believe" or a knee that is bent in gratitude.

He's talking about faith that is so strong it becomes action. This is the faith I hope I can have. (.
