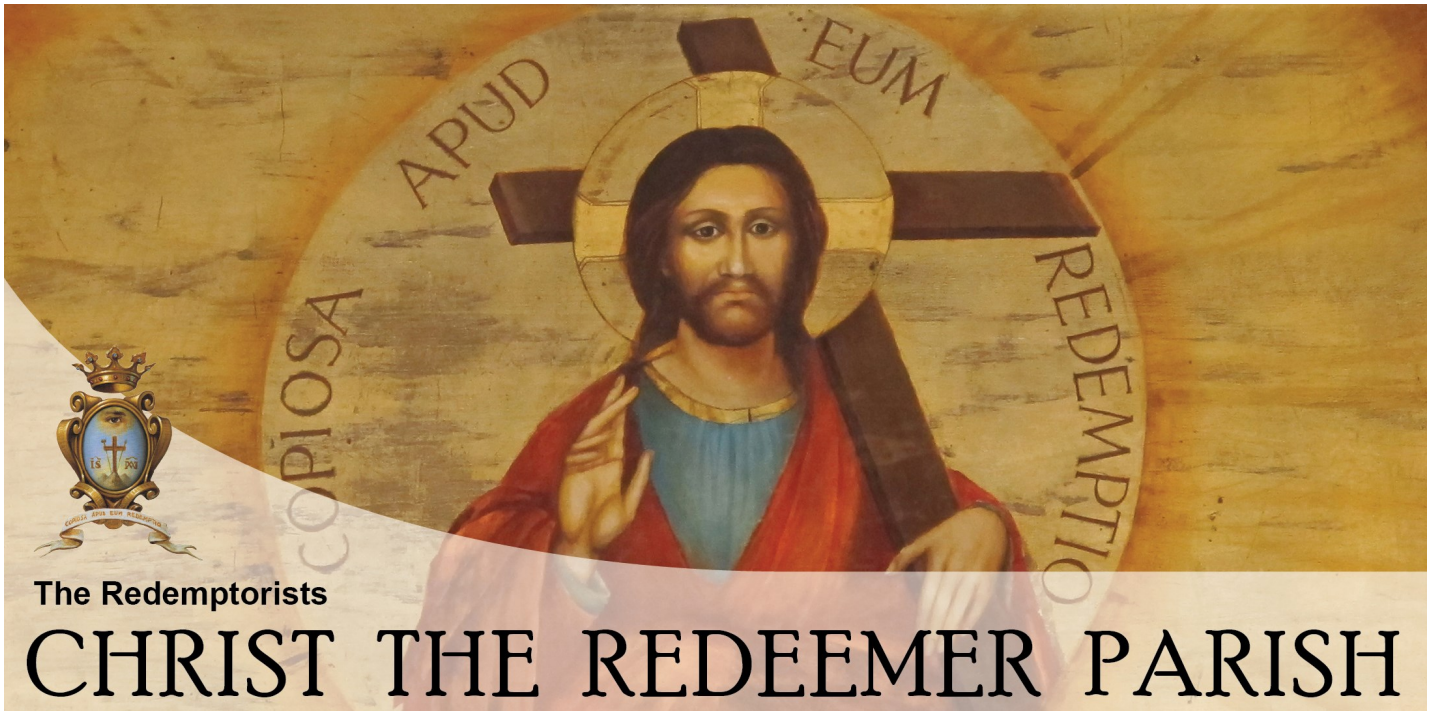

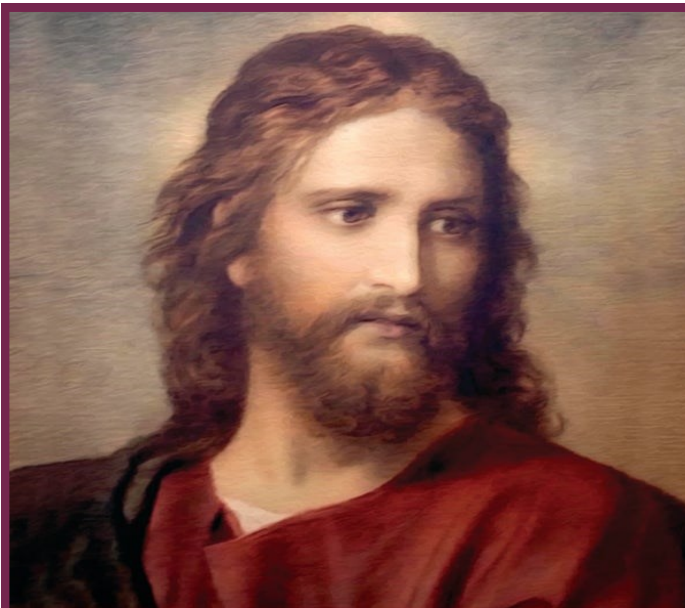

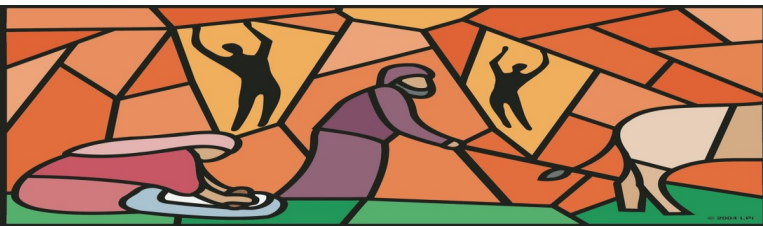

### GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

November 30, 2025

First Sunday of Advent Matthew 24:37-44

A few years ago, my house was broken into on Super Bowl Sunday. Turns out, it's a great day for burglars. If the TV isn't on, people are probably watching the game somewhere else, so ... easy pickins'. I'll never forget walking into my bedroom and realizing someone had been there. My stuff was thrown all over the floor. The closet was torn apart. It was disorienting and disturbing — someone had invaded the space I thought was secure. After that, I bought an alarm system. And every Super Bowl Sunday since, I'm extra careful to lock the doors and keep the lights on. That experience made me more alert. Not scared. Just attentive.

That's much like the spiritual place Jesus wants us to be on this first Sunday of Advent. He doesn't start the season with soft candlelight and cozy manger scenes. He starts with two brutal images: a flood and a thief. In other words, chaos and violation.

Why? Because life will flood us. Chaos will come. And in the midst of it, Christ will come like a thief — not to steal from us, but to steal us back. He is the intruder we should want. The one who breaks in, not to ransack, but to rescue.

Christ presents himself as the thief but also the new Noah. He builds the ark of the Church to carry us through the flood. And he invites us to join him. How? By participating fully in our parishes. By making our homes places of prayer. By guarding our hearts with truth. By refusing to let spiritual complacency leave us exposed. By repentance. This Advent, don't just stay vaguely "awake." Prepare. Build. Watch. The flood will come. But so will he. — Father John Muir

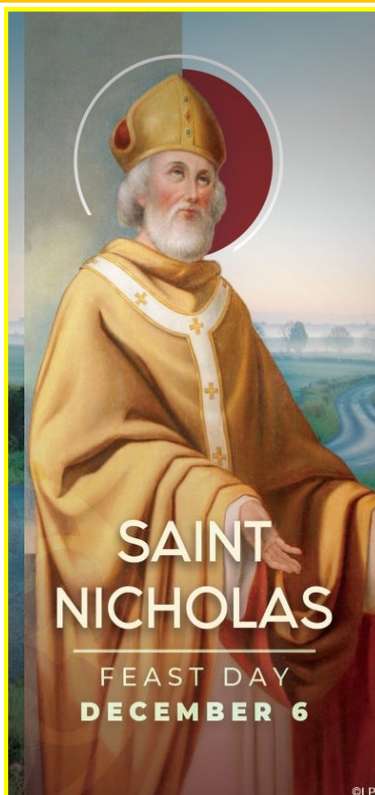
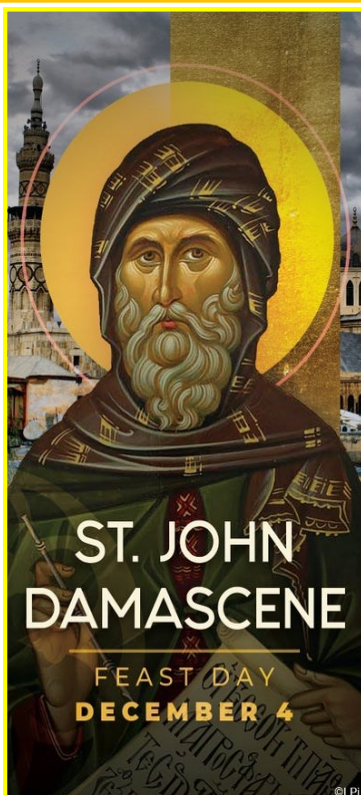
### **MEDYTACJA EWANGELICZNA – ZACHĘTA DO GŁĘBSZEGO ZROZUMIENIA PISMA ŚWIĘTEGO**

**30 listopada 2025**

**Pierwsza Niedziela Adwentu Ewangelia według św.  
Mateusza 24, 37–44**

Kilka lat temu włamano się do mojego domu w niedzielę Super Bowl. Okazało się, że to świetny dzień dla włamywaczy. Jeśli telewizor nie jest włączony, to znaczy, że ludzie pewnie oglądają mecz gdzie indziej, więc... łatwy łup. Nigdy nie zapomnę chwili, gdy wszedłem do sypialni i uświadomiłem sobie, że ktoś tam był. Moje rzeczy były porozrzucane po podłodze. Szafa przewrócona do góry nogami. Czuję się zdezorientowany i wstrząśnięty — ktoś wtargnął w przestrzeń, którą uważałem za bezpieczną. Po tym zdarzeniu kupiłem system alarmowy. I od tamtej pory, w każdą niedzielę Super Bowl, jestem wyjątkowo ostrożny — zamykam drzwi i zostawiam zapalone światła. To doświadczenie nauczyło mnie czujności. Nie lęku. Właśnie w takim stanie ducha Jezus chce nas widzieć w tę pierwszą niedzielę Adwentu. Nie rozpoczyna tego okresu od nastrojowego światła świec i cklowych scen w stajence. Zaczyna od dwóch mocnych obrazów: potopu i złodzieja.

Innymi słowy — chaosu i naruszenia bezpieczeństwa. Dlaczego? Bo życie nas „zaleje”. Chaos nadejdzie. A pośród niego przyjdzie Chrystus — jak złodziej. Nie po to, by nas okraść, lecz by nas odzyskać. On jest tym „włamywaczem”, którego powinniśmy pragnąć. Tym, który nie wchodzi, by plądrować, lecz by ratować. Chrystus przedstawia się jako złodziej, ale też jako nowy Noe. Buduje arkę Kościoła, by przeprowadzić nas przez potop. I zaprasza nas, byśmy z Nim weszli. Jak? Przez pełne uczestnictwo w życiu naszych parafii. Przez uczynienie z naszych domów miejsc modlitwy. Przez strzeżenie serca prawdą. Przez odrzucenie duchowego samozadowolenia. Przez nawrócenie. W tym Adwencie nie bądź tylko „ogólnie czujny”. Przygotuj się. Buduj. Czuwaj. Potop nadejdzie. Ale On także przyjdzie. — O. John Muir

## MILLENNIUM OF THE CROWN OF POLAND

On Sunday November 9, 2025, just before Polish Independence Day (November 11th), the Polish-American community of the Diocese of Metuchen gathered at St. John Paul II Church in Perth Amboy to celebrate the 1000th anniversary of the Polish Crown. The event featured a solemn Mass for the Homeland presided over by Fr. Stanisław Słaby, CSsR (Diocesan coordinator of Polish ministry), with a homily by Fr. Sławomir Romanowski, CSsR, a flag-raising ceremony by the Pulaski Cadets, and a roll call honoring those who died for Poland's freedom. Exhibits on the Polish monarchy and Ignacy Paderewski, along with a cultural program by Polish school students from Manville and Perth Amboy, enriched the celebration. A communal reception concluded the gathering, and heartfelt thanks were extended to all who helped make the event possible. #### EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP - RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

Some people hate surprise parties. There are those who are uncomfortable with a last-minute vacation or even an unexpected travel upgrade. If it wasn't part of the plan, it's a cause for consternation. There is a temptation to view these folks as curmudgeonly — sticks in the mud, obsessed with predictability. But I think if we're being honest, there's a little bit of the surprise-averse in all of us. Deep within the very heart of the element of surprise is a kernel of shock. And shock, in the moment, can feel similar to trauma. If we reflect on the most traumatic occurrences of our lives — a loss, an accident, a calamity — it is likely that we will say this: "It was the shock more than anything that got to me." Grief or fear, those feelings were overwhelming as well, but they came later. In the first moment, all we knew was we were going about our lives on one path until we were thrust on a different one and then the whole future changed. This is the natural rhythm of our life here on earth. We never know what is coming — which is to say, in a beautiful way, we always know what is coming. More importantly, we know Who is coming. Like the early riser who sets the "pre-alarm" (the one on which he knows he's going to hit snooze just to take the edge off the disappointment of waking up), we are always being given a heads-up in Scripture. From the earliest prophecies of the Messiah to Jesus' reminders in the Gospel to the very last words of Revelations, God has communicated to His stewards: You know the time. The time is now. We are called to constant vigilance, perpetual renewal, steadfast accountability. In the end, the coming of Christ may be the only event in history that was a surprise, but not a shock — and so it will only be beautiful, even for those who hate surprise parties. — Tracy Earl Welliver, MTS
