

## GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

March 22, 2026 5th Sunday of Lent

John 11:1-45

A friend of mine wrote an imaginative reflection on the raising of Lazarus that caught me off guard. She proposed that when Jesus called Lazarus from the tomb, the man was not joyful but angry and annoyed. After so much suffering, maybe death felt like a release. He had finally escaped the pain. And then, suddenly, Jesus' voice cuts through the silence:

"Lazarus, come out!" (John 11:43) The light stings his eyes. The pain returns. And now he is dragged back into a world that had broken him. It startled me at first, but the more I sat with it, the more it made sense. Sometimes, people do not want to be raised. Not at first. Think of those in the grip of addiction, despair, or numbness. The tomb can feel safer than the risk of living again. Yet Jesus, moved by the grief and faith of others (Martha, Mary, the community) calls the dead man out. Lazarus obeys. But he is still bound, head to foot.

Jesus says to the bystanders, "Untie him and let him go" (John 11:44).

That is often how healing happens: slowly, reluctantly. Not just by a personal decision, but through the love and persistence of others. Resurrection is not always euphoric. It may begin in protest and confusion and only later turn to gratitude and freedom. But Christ's voice breaks through, anyway.

Lenten challenge: Who in your life needs to be called back to life? Pray for them. If that person is you, listen for the voice. It is calling even now. — Father John Muir



Medytacja Ewangeliczna – ku głębszemu rozumieniu Pisma  
Świętego  
22 marca 2026 r.  
V Niedziela Wielkiego Postu  
J 11,1–45

Pewna moja znajoma napisała kiedyś bardzo interesującą refleksję nad Ewangelią o wskrzeszeniu Łazarza. Jej interpretacja początkowo mnie zaskoczyła. Zaproponowała bowiem, aby wyobrazić sobie, że gdy Jezus zawołał Łazarza z grobu, ten początkowo nie był pełen radości, lecz raczej ogarnięty gniewem i rozdrażnieniem. Po tak wielkim cierpieniu, którego doświadczył w życiu, śmierć mogła wydawać się wyzwoleniem. Wreszcie został uwolniony od bólu. I nagle ciszę przerywa głos Jezusa: „Łazarzu, wyjdź na zewnątrz!” (J 11,43).

Światło razi jego oczy, ból powraca, a on zostaje niejako przywrócony do świata, który wcześniej go zламаł. Początkowo taka wizja wydała mi się zaskakująca, lecz im dłużej nad nią zastanawiałem, tym bardziej dostrzegałem jej sens. Zdarza się bowiem, że człowiek nie chce zostać „wskrzeszony” – przynajmniej nie od razu. Pomyślmy o tych, którzy znajdują się w niewoli nałogu, rozpacz czy duchowej obojętności. Niekiedy „grób” wydaje się bezpieczniejszy niż powrót do życia. A jednak Jezus, poruszony zarówno żalem, jak i wiarą innych – Marty, Marii oraz całej wspólnoty – wskrzesza zmarłego. Łazarz odpowiada na to wezwanie, ale wychodzi mając ręce i nogi związane, a twarz owiniętą chustą.

Wtedy Jezus mówi do stojących obok: „Rozwiążcie go i pozwólcie mu chodzić” (J 11,44). Proces naszego uzdrowienia często dokonuje się: powoli, niekiedy z naszym oporem. Ale jest on również możliwy dzięki miłości i wytrwałości innych.


Zmartwychwstanie nie zawsze rozpoczyna się od euforii. Czasem zaczyna się od sprzeciwu, zagubienia i pytań. Dopiero później prowadzi do wdzięczności i prawdziwej wolności. Tym co zawsze się będzie przebijając przez ciszę grobu to głos Chrystusa. Wielkopostne wyzwanie:

Kto w twoim życiu potrzebuje dziś usłyszeć wezwanie do powrotu do życia? Módl się za tę osobę. A jeśli tą osobą jesteś Ty sam – wsłuchaj się w głos Chrystusa, który wzywa do prawdziwego życia. — o. John Muir



**Lenten Obligations**

1. The days of fast and abstinence are Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.
2. All other Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence.
3. The obligation of fast applies only to Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59.  
 Fasting in the Catholic tradition means to limit one-self to one full meal and two smaller meals which together are not equal to a full meal, so as to experience hunger.
4. The obligation of abstinence applies to all Catholics who have reached the age of 14.  
 Abstinence in the Catholic tradition means to abstain from meat.
