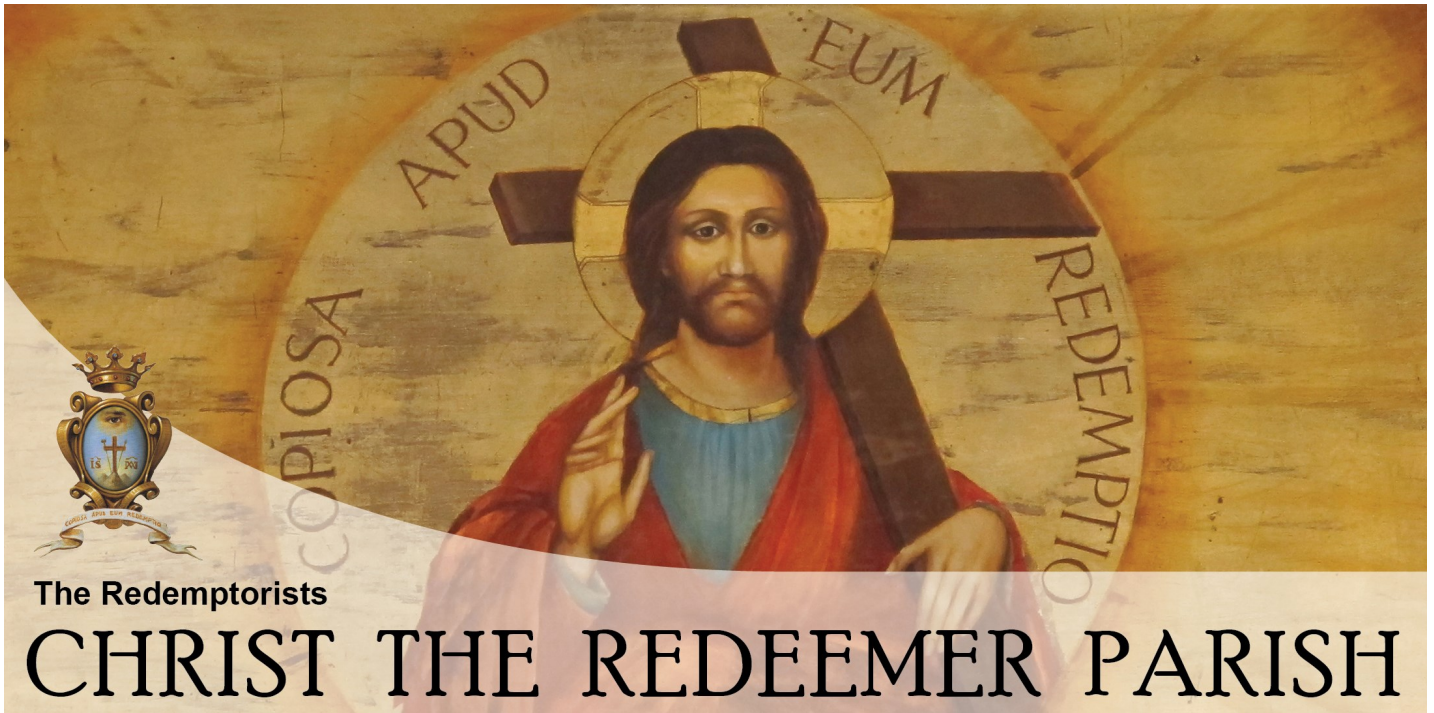

### GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

May 3, 2026

5th Sunday of Easter

John 14:1-12

We generally approach life with the question, “What can this do for me?” We try a new workout, a low-carb diet, intermittent fasting, or a new career path, hoping it will make us healthier, stronger, happier. The assumption is that if I invest in this, I’ll eventually reap some benefit, or I won’t do it.

It is easy to think of faith the same way: if I really practice my faith, what will it do for me? Will it make me calmer, more moral, more successful?

But in today’s Gospel, Jesus says something astonishing. He doesn’t present himself as a teacher who shows us the way to life. He says, “I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life.” (John 14:6) He is not merely a guide toward some higher benefit. He is the benefit itself. To know him is to know Life.

Thomas Aquinas explains that every desire in the human heart — love, joy, meaning, all of our restless cravings — is really an indirect cry for life. Even despair testifies to this longing: people despair precisely because they feel they are not, and might never be, fully alive.

The good news is that Jesus is not simply the means to a better life; He is Life itself. To believe in him is to share in God’s own eternal vitality. Not simply later but even now. Faith is not a transaction that produces results — it is a union that fills us with joy. To be in communion with Christ is to be truly, fully alive.— Father John Muir

### MEDYTACJA EWANGELICZNA – ZACHĘTA DO GŁĘBSZEGO ZROZUMIENIA PISMA ŚWIĘTEGO

3 maja 2026 r.

V Niedziela Wielkanocna

J 14, 1–12

Zwykle podchodzimy do życia z pytaniem: „Co ja z tego będę miał?” Próbujemy nowych ćwiczeń, diety nisko węglowodanowej, postu przerywanego czy nowej ścieżki kariery, mając nadzieję, że uczyni nas to zdrowszymi, silniejszymi i szczęśliwszymi. Zakładamy, że jeśli w coś zainwestuję, to w końcu odniosę z tego jakąś korzyść — w przeciwnym razie nie warto.

Łatwo jest myśleć w ten sam sposób o wierze: jeśli naprawdę będę ją praktykował, co mi to da? Czy stanę się spokojniejszy, bardziej moralny, bardziej spełniony?

Jednak w dzisiejszej Ewangelii Jezus mówi coś zdumiewającego. Nie przedstawia się jako nauczyciel, który pokazuje drogę do życia. Mówi: „Ja jestem drogą, prawdą i życiem” (J 14,6). Nie jest jedynie przewodnikiem prowadzącym do jakiegoś wyższego dobra. On sam jest tym dobrem. Poznać Go — to poznać Życie.

Święty Tomasz z Akwinu wyjaśnia, że każde pragnienie ludzkiego serca — miłość, radość, sens, wszystkie nasze niespokojne tęsknoty — jest w istocie pośrednim wołaniem o życie. Nawet rozpacz o tym świadczy: ludzie popadają w rozpacz właśnie dlatego, że czują, iż nie są — i być może nigdy nie będą — w pełni żywi.

Dobra nowina jest taka, że Jezus nie jest jedynie środkiem do lepszego życia; On sam jest Życiem. Wierzyć w Niego oznacza mieć udział w Bożej, wiecznej żywotności. Nie tylko kiedyś, ale już teraz. Wiara nie jest transakcją przynoszącą określone rezultaty — jest zjednoczeniem, które napełnia nas radością. Być w komunii z Chrystusem to być naprawdę, w pełni żywym.

**Mass Etiquette:**

**Do not leave Mass early.** You should stay to the end of the recession and the hymn that accompanies it. While there are from time to time exceptions to this (emergencies do happen), most who leave early don't need to and ought not to. Please stay through the final blessing.

**Show up at least a few minutes early.** Getting to Mass early allows you to pray and prepare yourself for Mass.

Feel free to kneel and pray before Mass!

**Don't chew gum in church.** This breaks your fast, it is distracting, it is considered impolite in any formal setting especially Mass!

**Fast before Mass.** It is Church law that one fasts for at least 1 hour before receiving Holy Communion. Water and medicine can be consumed, of course. The purpose is to help us prepare to receive Jesus in the Eucharist.

**Communion** When receiving Holy Communion, once you have received the Sacred Host in your hand consume the Host immediately & directly in front of the Priest, Deacon or Eucharistic Minister. Do not walk back to your seat with the host.

### Witnesses for Jesus

For them, Jesus becomes what Peter wrote about when he described Jesus as the stone that causes people to stumble and the rock that makes them fall. A friend of mine who had family members belonging to several  
different religions once told me that there were as many different  
routes to Heaven as there were to the grocery store.

This was an analogy her family had used to remember that they  
all sought the same thing — God — even though they were going  
about the search in different ways. I've thought a lot about her  
words in the years since she shared them with me. It's not an un-  
true analogy — there are a lot of different routes to the grocery  
store. An infinite number, in fact. There is actually no "right"  
way to get to the grocery store, because it all depends on where  
you're starting from and what other errands you have along the  
way. And there are a lot of different routes to Heaven — like-  
wise, an infinite number. It all depends on where you're starting  
from. It all depends on what you have to do along the way.

There it is: the part that matters. The way. Whether we're talking  
about Heaven or the grocery store as our destination, all routes  
are not created equal. Some take too long. Some are impassable.  
Some are hard to navigate. Some are just plain made-up — the

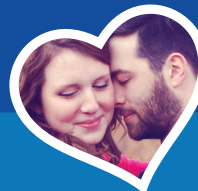
