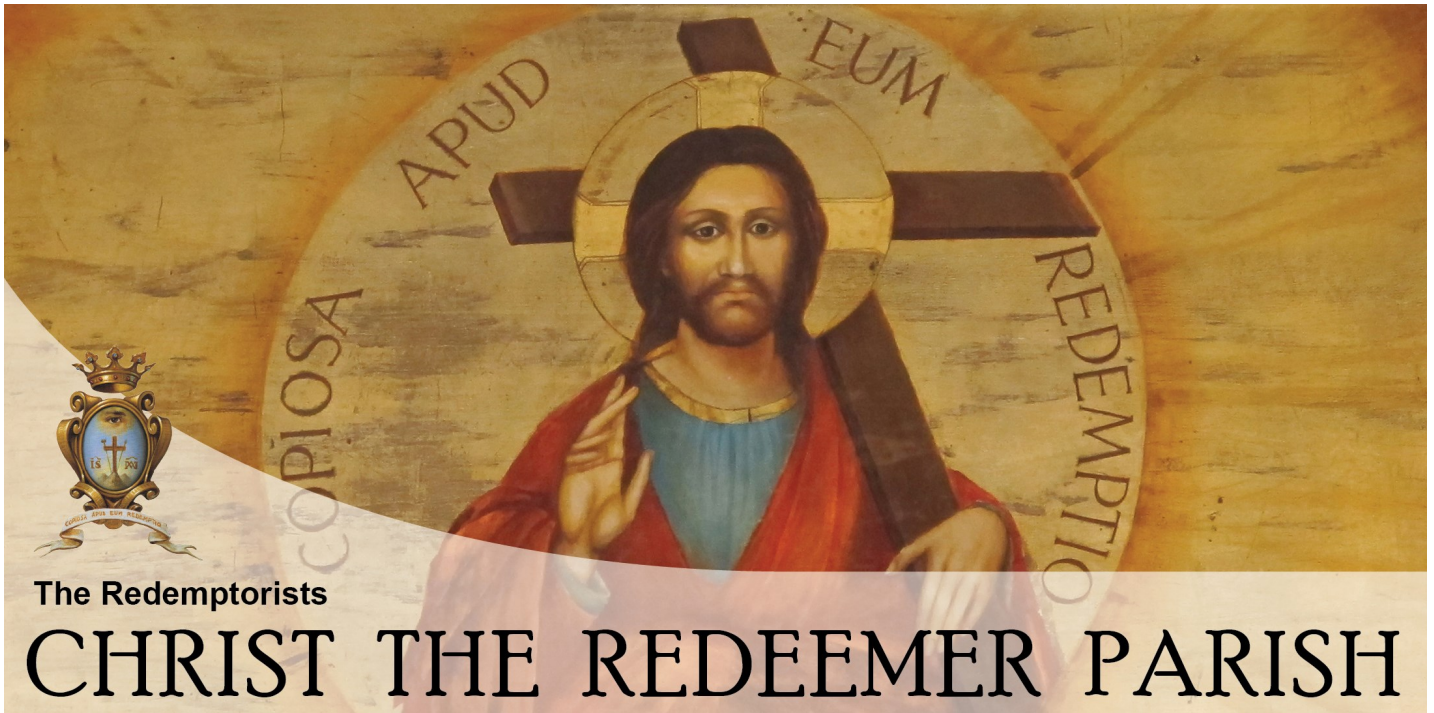

#### GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

May 10, 2026

6th Sunday of Easter

John 14:15-21

In my family, we can hardly speak about orphans without tears. My father was adopted as a baby. He frequently told us stories of how his parents welcomed him not just into their home but into their hearts. It was never merely a relocation or a legal transaction. It was the joy of being chosen, of receiving a family, a name, and a place where he belonged forever. Even in his later years, recalling that gift still moves him to tears of tender gratitude.

That is the kind of tenderness behind Jesus' words in today's Gospel: "I will not leave you orphans; I will come to you." (John 14:18) He is going away, but not abandoning us. Instead, he sends us the Advocate, the Holy Spirit — his own Spirit, shared with the Father — who dwells in us. Through the Spirit, Christ is present in us, and we are present in him. His Spirit gives us a home and a family.

We deepen this knowledge in the sacraments, in prayer, and in the daily life of the Church. The Spirit is the bond of belonging, the power that makes us God's sons and daughters, not spiritual orphans. And this is not a one-time event. There is always a deeper outpouring of the Spirit available to us, a fresh appropriation of the promise that we are never abandoned.

If only we could be as grateful as my dad is for his adoption, realizing that we have been adopted by God Himself. In Christ, we are never left as orphans. — Father John Muir

MEDYTACJA EWANGELICZNA – ZACHĘTA DO  
GŁĘBSZEGO ROZUMIENIA PISMA ŚWIĘTEGO

10 maja 2026

6. Niedziela Wielkanocna

J 14,15–21

W mojej rodzinie trudno nie mówić o sierotach bez wyraźnego wzruszenia. Mój ojciec został adoptowany jako niemowlę. Często opowiadał nam, jak jego adopcyjni rodzice przyjęli go nie tylko do swojego domu, ale przede wszystkim do swoich serc. Nie była to jedynie zmiana miejsca zamieszkania czy formalność prawna. Była to radość bycia wybranym — otrzymania rodziny, nazwiska i miejsca, do którego należy się na zawsze. Nawet w późniejszych latach, gdy o tym wspominał, wciąż ogarniało go głębokie, wdzięczne wzruszenie.

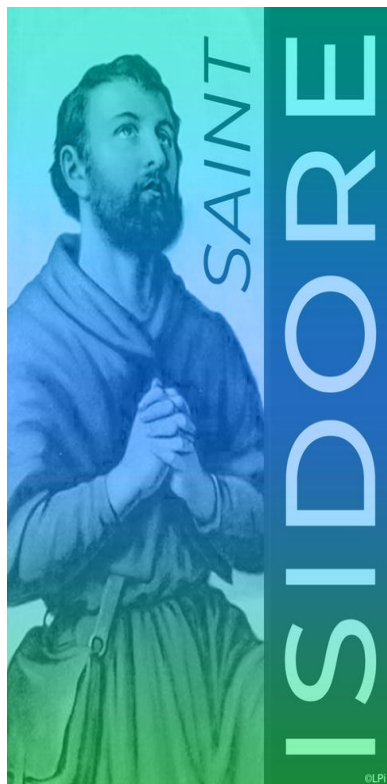
Taka właśnie czułość kryje się za słowami Jezusa z dzisiejszej Ewangelii: „Nie zostawię was sierotami; przyjdę do was” (J 14,18). Jezus odchodzi, ale nas nie opuszcza. Posyła nam Pocieszyciela — Ducha Świętego — swojego własnego Ducha, którego dzieli z Ojcem, a który w nas zamieszkuje. Dzięki Duchowi Świętemu Chrystus jest obecny w nas, a my jesteśmy obecni w Nim. Jego Duch daje nam dom i rodzinę.

Pogłębiany tę prawdę poprzez sakramenty, modlitwę i codzienne życie Kościoła. Duch Święty jest więzią przynależności, mocą, która czyni nas dziećmi Bożymi, a nie duchowymi sierotami. I nie jest to jednorazowe wydarzenie. Zawsze możemy doświadczać coraz obfitszego wylania Ducha Świętego, na nowo przyjmować obietnicę, że nigdy nie jesteśmy sami.

Gdybyśmy tylko potrafili być tak wdzięczni jak mój ojciec za dar adopcji, uświadamiając sobie, że zostaliśmy wybrani przez samego Boga.

(PRACTICING) CATHOLIC - RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

“What if you are the only version of Christ someone sees today?” a friend once asked me. My blood ran cold. Jeez, I thought. That would be...really unfortunate. The world cannot accept the Holy Spirit, Christ tells us, because the world cannot see and know the Holy Spirit (John 14:17). But the world can see us. The world can know us. In this way, we accomplish the Great Commission: we go forth, and we make disciples of all nations. In all that we are and all that we do, we offer an explanation for our hope (1 Peter 3:15). We face a unique situation, 2,000 years after the Resurrection, because our mission field is full of people who have already heard about Christ. And they have zero interest, thanks-and-please-get-off-my-porch. This Christ they’ve seen? He puts himself first. He’s suspicious of other people. He’s not interested in mixing with the wrong crowd. He’s been known to lie, to abuse trust, to protect himself. Here’s the problem: they haven’t seen Christ at all. They’ve only seen Christians. It’s easy to blame the obvious culprits: the priest consumed in public scandal, the parish trustee who stole from the coffers. But these are only larger versions of the same failure of which I am guilty each time I shiver at the thought of someone associating my behavior, my words, and my attitude with my Savior. I am not Christ. I am nowhere close. But I am fortunate enough to be a member of his Body. We all fail, of course. Every apostle, every saint, every bishop, every priest, every man and woman in the pews: we are all broken. We are all in need of redemption. When we accept that redemption, however, we also accept responsibility. Because now, we become what the world sees of Christ.  
Am I ready to be the only version of Christ someone sees today?

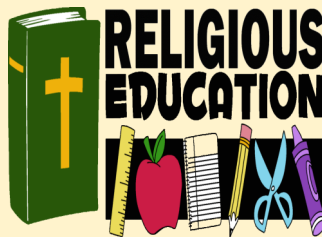

## The 2026-27 Religious Education School Year Begins Sept 29th

Registration for the 2026-27 Christ the Redeemer Religious Education Program opens on Friday May 15th. Parents of students from the just completed school year will receive an email from Parish Giving on the morning that registration opens. This email will contain login credentials for a Parish Giving account that was created for you. There is no need for you to create a Parish Giving account. If registration opens and you don't receive this automated email, please contact the parish office.

For families registering a child for CCD for the first time you will need to complete a form which can found on the religious education page of the parish website. Once you complete this form, the office will be notified and will review your application. If approved you will receive an automated email from Parish Giving with login credentials that was created for you.

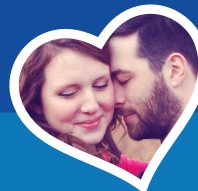
