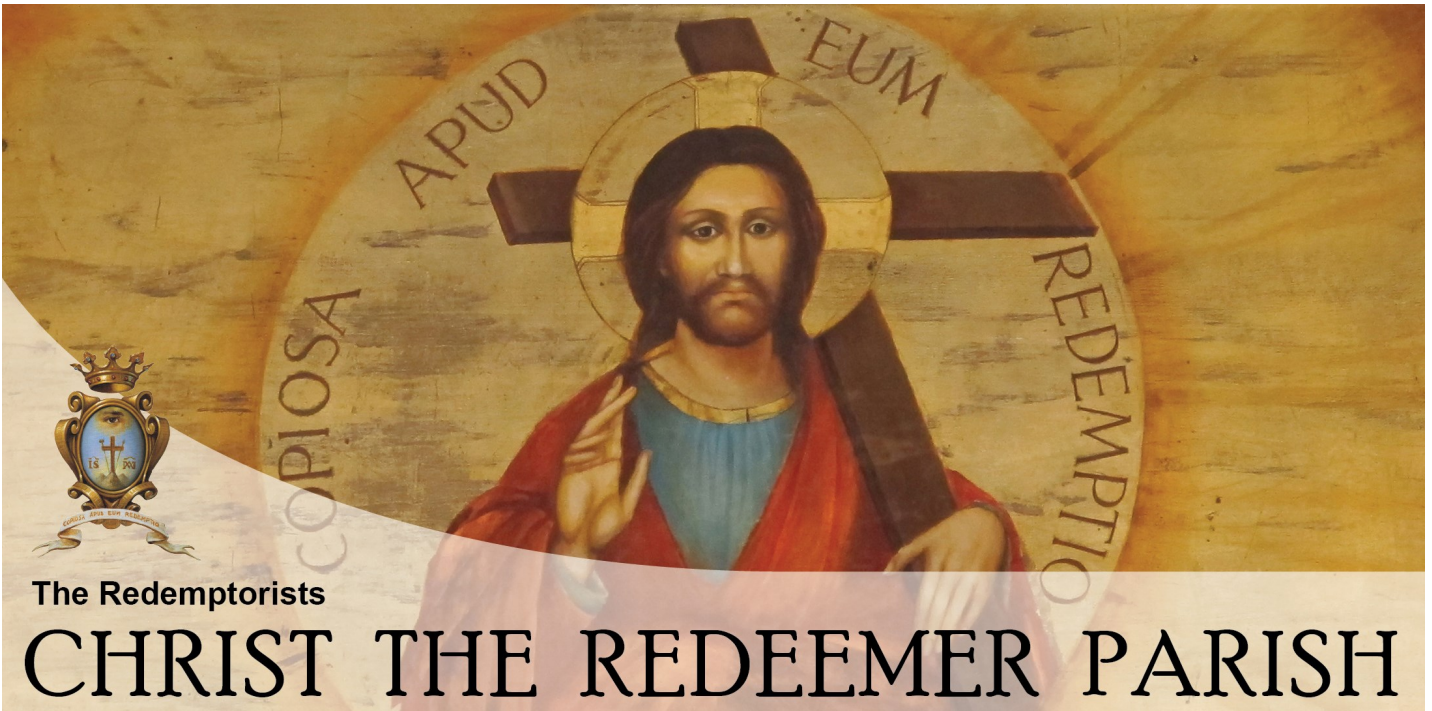

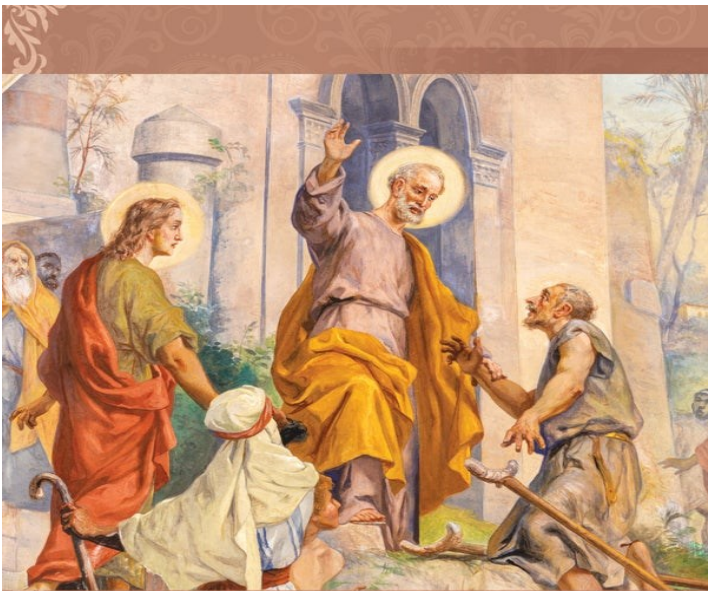

GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

June 14, 2026

11th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Matthew 9:36-10:8

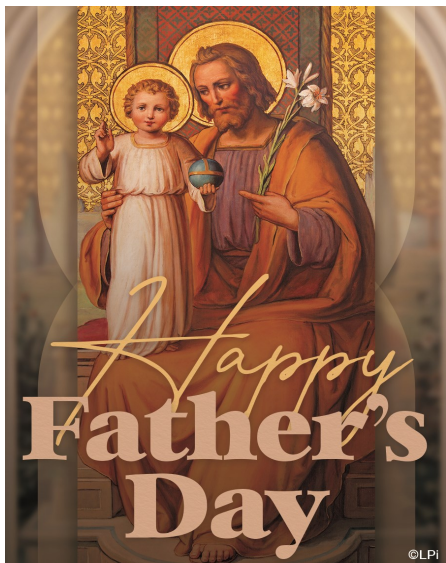
A few years ago, I met a woman in my parish who was a successful lawyer. Yet in her free time, she poured her energy into a nonprofit she founded to advocate for children with special needs. When I asked what inspired her, she spoke of her niece, who was born with disabilities. Her niece was both a glorious gift and a constant challenge. Out of that painful, beautiful experience, she felt called to create something lasting for other children and parents. The nonprofit thrived, not because she had mapped it all out, but because she was deeply moved to act.

In today’s Gospel, Jesus is “moved with compassion” for the crowd, for they were “like sheep without a shepherd.” (Matthew 9:36) So he calls his disciples, ordinary men with no special qualifications, and sends them to heal, preach, and cast out demons. Their mission flows not from their skills but from his authority and the Spirit’s gifts.

The Second Vatican Council teaches that the Spirit continually pours out charisms, special graces for the good of the Church and the world (cf. Lumen Gentium 4 & 12). These often arise from the unfolding of our lives: from what breaks your heart, what fills you with hope, what suffering has shaped you. The Spirit works through those very experiences to equip us with gifts that build up others. What is your charism? Well, what needs around you call you to loving action? This could be where Christ is sending you. Allow your heart to be moved like Christ’s. Then get to work.

MEDYTACJA EWANGELICZNA – ZACHĘTA DO GŁĘBSZEGO ZROZUMIENIA PISMA ŚWIĘTEGO

14 czerwca 2026

11. Niedziela Zwykła

Mt. 9,36–10,8

Kilka lat temu w mojej parafii poznałem kobietę, która była odnoszącą sukcesy prawniczką. Mimo wielu obowiązków w wolnym czasie poświęcała swoją energię organizacji non-profit, którą założyła, aby wspierać dzieci specjalnej troski. Kiedy zapytałem ją, co ją zainspirowało, opowiedziała o swojej siostrzenicy, która urodziła się z niepełnosprawnościami. Dziewczynka była wspaniałym darem, ale i nieustannym wyzwaniem. Z tego bolesnego, ale pięknego doświadczenia zrodziło się w niej pragnienie stworzenia czegoś trwałego dla innych dzieci i rodziców. Organizacja rozkwitła nie dlatego, że wszystko dokładnie zaplanowała, ale dlatego, że została głęboko poruszona i poczuła potrzebę działania.

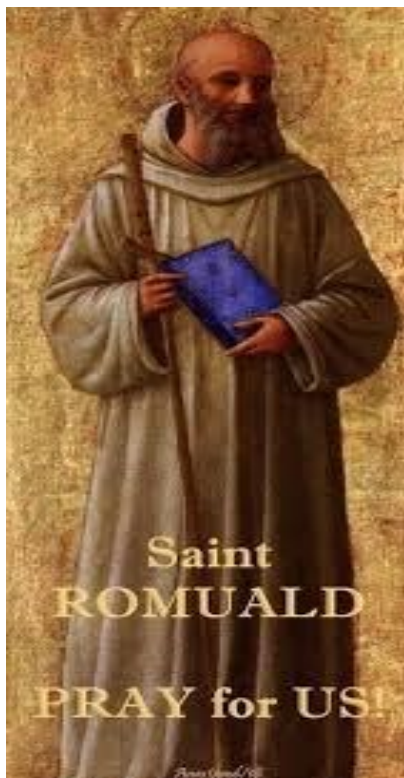
W dzisiejszej Ewangelii Jezus „ulitował się nad tłumem”, ponieważ ludzie byli „jak owce niemające pasterza” (Mt 9,36).

Jezus powołuje swoich uczniów — zwykłych ludzi bez szczególnych kwalifikacji — i posyła ich, aby uzdrawiali, głosili Dobrą Nowinę i wyrzucali złe duchy. Ich misja wpływa nie z ich umiejętności, ale z Jego autorytetu i darów Ducha Świętego.

Sobór Watykański II naucza, że Duch Święty nieustannie udziela charyzmatów, czyli szczególnych łask dla dobra Kościoła i świata (por. Lumen Gentium 4 i 12). Często rodzą się one z wydarzeń naszego życia: z tego, co trudne, ale i z tego co napędza nas nadzieją. Duch działa właśnie poprzez te doświadczenia, aby wyposażyć nas w dary służące budowaniu innych.

Jaki jest Twój charyzmat? Jakie potrzeby wokół Ciebie wzywają Cię do działania z miłością? Być może właśnie tam Chrystus Cię posyła. Pozwól, aby Twoje serce zostało poruszone jak serce Chrystusa. Niech to Cię motywuje do działania

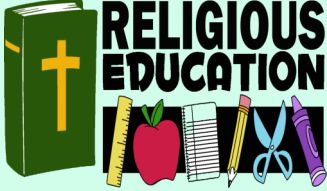

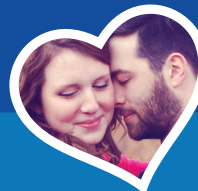
