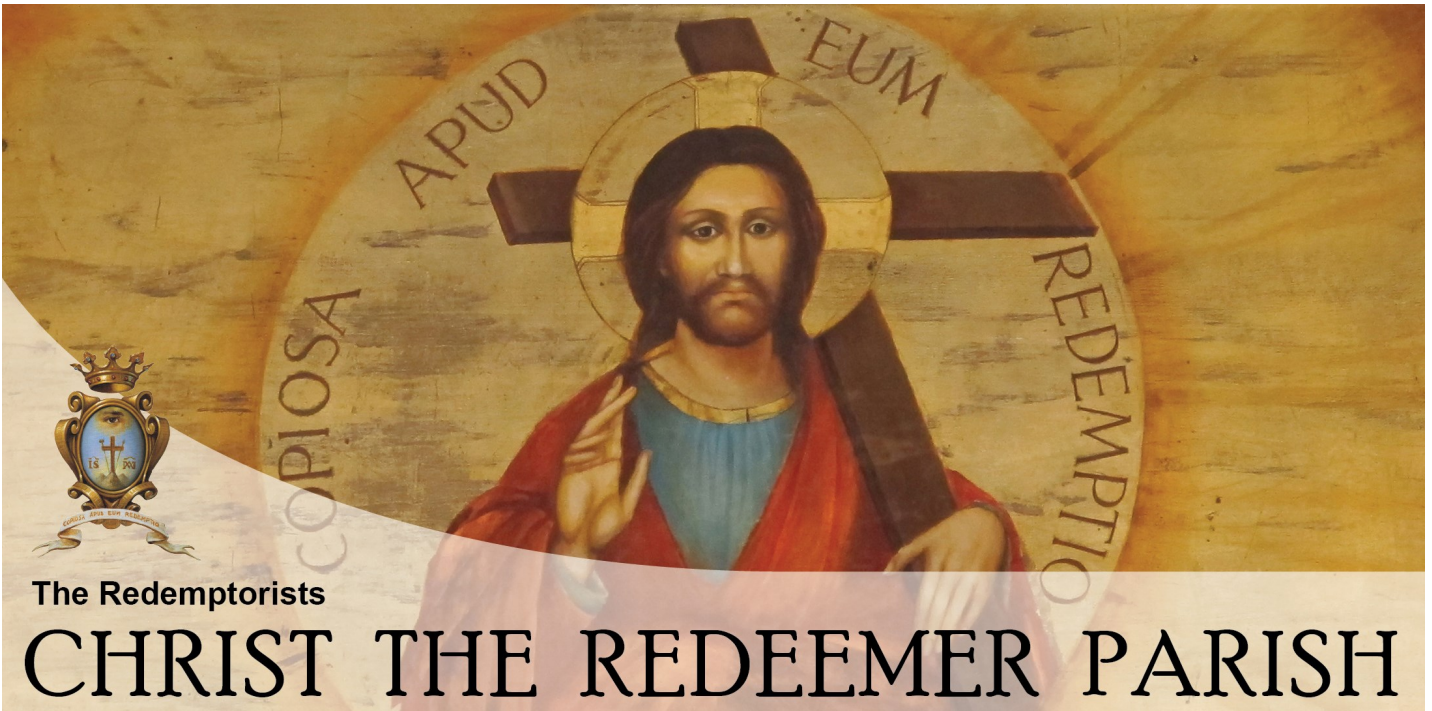

GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

June 21, 2026 12th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Matthew 10:26-33

Jean Améry, a Holocaust survivor tortured by the Nazis, later wrote about the abyss of human evil. He described his reaction as an “indignant despair.” Haven’t we all, to some degree, felt that abyss opened beneath us? A sudden loss, a violent headline, a moment of loneliness or panic, when the world feels fragile and meaning seems to collapse?

It is to this fear that Jesus speaks in today’s Gospel: “Do not be afraid of those who can kill the body.” (Matthew 10:28) He does not deny evil or pretend we will never suffer. Instead, He reframes the abyss: do not fear those who can kill the body but cannot kill the soul. Your life is seen, known, and counted by the Father. Even the hairs of your head, even the sparrow’s fall. This is no superficial comfort. Jesus himself has entered the abyss: suffering, death, even our sense of forsakenness, and he has come through it. That is why his words, “Do not be afraid,” hold such weight. They do not erase the abyss but build a bridge across it. Faith is not pretending everything is fine. It is staring into the abyss and still choosing trust. And in that trust, we discover we are never alone. Christ stands with us, and the Father’s care surrounds us. That is the only comfort deep enough for our (often fearful) hearts.

MEDYTACJA EWANGELII – ZACHĘTA DO GŁĘBSZEGO ZROZUMIENIA PISMA ŚWIĘTEGO

12. Niedziela Zwyczajła

Ewangelia: Mt 10, 26-33

Jean Améry, ocalały z Holocaustu, torturowany przez nazistów, napisał później o tym doświadczeniu jako o doświadczeniu otchłani ludzkiego zła. Opisał to jako „oburzoną rozpacz”.

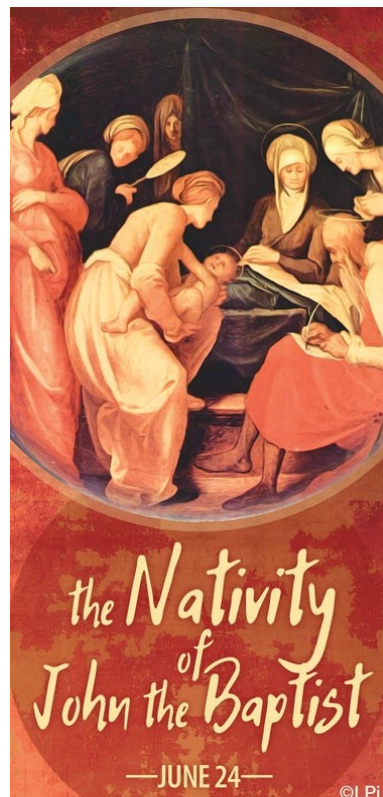
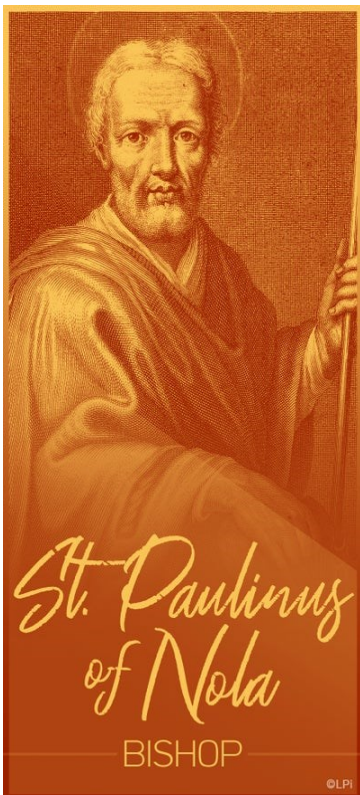
Czyż nie my wszyscy, w pewnym stopniu, doświadczamy takiej otchłani w naszym życiu? Nagła strata bliskiej osoby, wstrząsający nagłówek wiadomości, chwila samotności lub paniki, kiedy świat wydaje się kruchy, a sens życia jakby się rozpadał?

To właśnie do tego lęku nawiązuje Jezus w dzisiejszej Ewangelii: „Nie bójcie się tych, którzy zabijają ciało.” (Mt 10,28) Nie zaprzecza istnieniu zła ani nie udaje, że nigdy nie będziemy cierpieć. Zamiast tego nadaje temu doświadczeniu nowe znaczenie: "Nie bójcie się tych, którzy mogą zabić ciało, ale nie mogą zabić duszy." Twoje życie jest widziane i znane przez Ojca. "Nawet włosy na Twojej głowie są policzone."

To nie jest powierzchowne pocieszenie. Sam Jezus wszedł w tę otchłani: cierpienie, śmierć, opuszczenie — i przeszedł przez nią zwycięsko. Dlatego Jego słowa: „Nie bójcie się” mają tak wielką moc. Nie usuwają otchłani, ale budują nad nią most.

Wiara nie polega na udawaniu, że wszystko jest w porządku. To spojrzenie w otchłani i wybór zaufania pomimo wszystko. A w tym zaufaniu odkrywamy, że nigdy nie jesteśmy sami. Chrystus stoi przy nas, a Ojciec otacza nas swoją troską. To jedyne pocieszenie wystarczająco głębokie dla naszych często pełnych lęku serc.

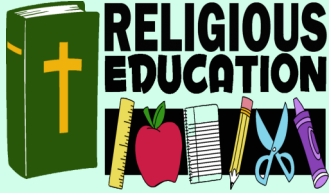

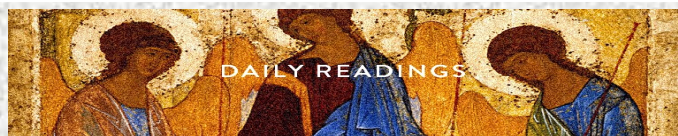

EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP - RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

You find yourself in the difficult situation of being accused of blasphemy and confronting possible execution. Your crime is believing in Jesus Christ. The question is then asked of you, "Are you a Christian, a follower of the one named Jesus Christ?" Your answer may very well dictate what happens to you next. What is your answer? It is probably easier to answer this question when the scenario is make-believe. All of us want to believe that we would say yes to the question of belief in Jesus, but strange things happen when humans panic in the face of extreme stress. As we reflect on what we would say, there are those all over the world who are being asked that very same question. It is a question that was asked of many in the first centuries of the Church. Those who respond "yes" are considered martyrs and saints.

We might not usually think of all this in terms of good stewardship living. However, our faith is also a gift we have received from God to cultivate, grow, and share with others. The more interesting question than the one posed above is, "Would an accuser even think of asking you such a question?" Would you have cultivated, grown, and shared your faith enough that anyone would even consider you worthy of asking the question? They might assume you don't know Jesus Christ at all. I don't like conflict and do not seek out conflict, but I would rather someone ask the first question posed than assume there is no reason to confront me in the first place.

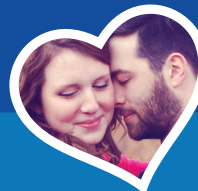
