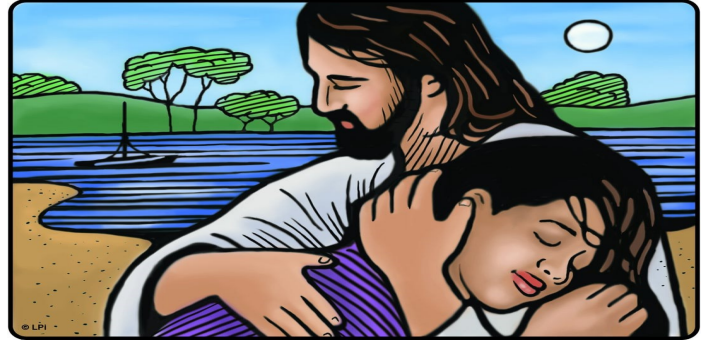

GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

July 5, 2026 Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Matthew 11:25-30

This weekend, our nation celebrates the 250th anniversary of the signing of the Declaration of Independence. Unlike most nations, the United States was not founded primarily on a shared ethnicity, language, or culture. Instead, our founders built a political community out of diverse peoples united by a shared vision of liberty. That vision echoes something deep in the Christian mystery revealed in today's Gospel.

Jesus returns to his hometown. The people see only what is familiar: the carpenter, the son of Mary, one of their own. As Mark tells us, “They took offense at him. Jesus said, ‘A prophet is not without honor except in his native place and among his own kin and in his own house.’” Their narrow vision blinds them. Jesus has come to inaugurate a new communion that transcends geography, bloodlines, and culture. He has come to unite all people in himself.

At its best, America's national unity reflects this possibility, which fully subsists only in the Catholic Church. Our unity is not based on ancestry or tribe, but on a shared commitment to higher ideals. For this reason, we can love our country with gratitude while situating patriotism within the broader horizon of faith.

Rooted in Christ, we are less vulnerable to the unholy tribalism that threatens civic life and faith. This weekend, let us thank God for our nation and pray that we also live as citizens of Heaven in Jesus Christ. — Father John Muir

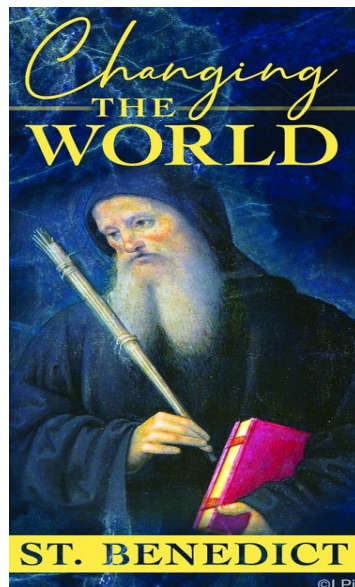
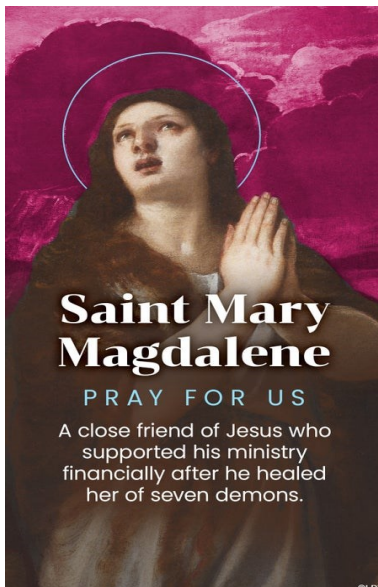
### MEDYTACJA EWANGELICZNA – ZACHĘTA DO GŁĘBSZEGO ROZUMIENIA PISMA ŚWIĘTEGO

5 lipca 2026 XIV Niedziela Zwykła  
Mt 11,25-30

W ten weekend Stany Zjednoczone obchodzą 250. rocznicę podpisania Deklaracji Niepodległości. W przeciwieństwie do większości państw, Stany Zjednoczone nie zostały założone na wspólnym pochodzeniu etnicznym, języku czy kulturze. Ojcowie założyciele stworzyli wspólnotę polityczną złożoną z różnych narodów, zjednoczonych wspólną wizją wolności. Ta wizja odzwierciedla głęboką prawdę z chrześcijańskiej perspektywy objawionej w dzisiejszej Ewangelii.

Jezus powraca do swojego rodzinnego miasta. Ludzie widzą w Nim jedynie to, co dobrze znają: cieślę, syna Maryi, jednego z nich. Jak mówi św. Marek: „Powątpiewali o Nim. A Jezus mówił im: ‘Tylko w swojej ojczyźnie, wśród swoich krewnych i w swoim domu może być prorok lekceważony’”. Ich ograniczone spojrzenie staje się dla nich przeszkodą. Jezus przyszedł bowiem, aby zapoczątkować nową wspólnotę, która przekracza granice geografii, więzów krwi i kultury. Przyszedł, aby zjednoczyć wszystkich ludzi w sobie. W najlepszym wymiarze jedność narodowa Ameryki odzwierciedla tę możliwość, która w pełni realizuje się jedynie w Kościele katolickim. Nasza jedność nie opiera się na pochodzeniu czy przynależności plemiennej, ale na wspólnym dążeniu do wyższych wartości. Dlatego możemy kochać naszą ojczyznę z wdzięcznością, jednocześnie widząc patriotyzm w szerszej perspektywie wiary.

Zakotwiczeni w Chrystusie, jesteśmy mniej podatni na niezdrowy trybalizm i podziały, które zagrażają zarówno życiu społecznemu, jak i wierze. W ten weekend dziękujemy Bogu za nasz naród i módlmy się, abyśmy żyli również jako obywatele Nieba w Jezusie Chrystusie. — Ojciec John Muir

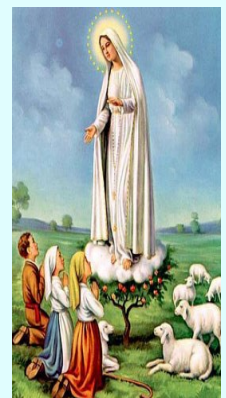

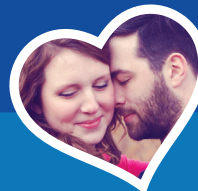
